### **WHO** can submit nominations?

### **WHAT** is the \$500 Teacher Environmental Mini-Grant Award?

A \$500 award for a program for excellence in the area of environmental awareness and enhancement through curriculum development, special projects and/or extra-curricular activities will be awarded to **one teacher** during the **2011-2012** school year to support his/her project.

- innovative
- integrated into science curriculum – standards based
- “hands-on” activity with students
- objective, action steps, and conclusions clearly stated
- technology component
